PRE-SURGERY CHECKLIST

30 Days Prior to Surgery

- Please call your insurance company to confirm your financial responsibilities for the surgery.
- Schedule an appointment for your history and physical with your primary care physician, within 30 days of your surgery. Please have it faxed to 952-456-7901 at least 7 days prior to your scheduled surgery.

Medications: Discuss all medications/ supplements you currently take with your family physician. If you currently take any anticoagulation medication (blood thinners) or aspirin, talk to the prescribing doctor about dosing before and after surgery.

7 Days Prior to Surgery

□ Complete your Pre-Admission Survey.

If a cell phone number was provided, you will receive a text message from Two Twelve Surgery Center asking you to "opt in" for text messaging. If you agree and respond "Yes", you will receive a text with a link to complete your pre-admissions survey. If you do no "opt in", you will receive this link via email if email was provided.

If an email or cell phone was not provided, a paper copy will be provided to complete upon check-in. Please bring a list of your medications to complete this form.

- Verify that you have a ride home from surgery. You cannot use a cab, medical transport or drive home after surgery. Your driver must be at least 18 years of age and be available immediately after your surgery is completed. We recommend they stay at the surgery center during your procedure so they can meet with the surgeon.
- Verify that you have a responsible adult to stay with you for at least 24 hours after surgery. We require this for all patients who receive anesthesia, and please be aware that additional help may be needed after 24 hours.

24 Hours Prior to Surgery

- The night before your surgery, complete your first shower, using Hibiclens antibacterial soap. Please see other side of brochure for instructions on obtaining and using Hibiclens.
- A representative from the Surgery Center will call you one business day prior to your scheduled surgery day with this information.
- Follow instructions for stopping all food, drink and tobacco products, provided by the preoperative phone call.

Day of Surgery

- Prior to arrival, complete your second shower, using Hibiclens antibacterial soap.
- Do not wear contact lenses on day of surgery and bring case for glasses.
- Please follow the plan for medication dosing as instructed by your primary care physician. Wear your hearing aids, if applicable.
- □ Bring your inhaler, if applicable.
- Wear large, loose-fitting clothing (no jeans) that you can easily take off and put on before and after surgery. You may need to cover large bandages, slings or a cast. Be sure your clothing will accommodate your surgical dressing. Women may wear a sports bra or bra without metal, including hooks and underwire.
- Bring your I.D. and insurance card(s). Please leave all other valuables at home (jewelry, purses, etc.). Two Twelve Surgery Center is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- Be prepared to pick up your prescription at a pharmacy on the way home.
- □ Bring CPAP machine, if applicable.
- Bring any durable medical equipment (crutches, boots, slings, etc.) that you may have received at your clinic appointment.
- □ Bring this folder to surgery appointment.

Obtaining Hibiclens Antibacterial Soap

Guide for Using Hibiclens Antibacterial Soap

- You will complete two showers using Hibiclens. You will take one shower the night before your surgery and one the morning of surgery.
- If you plan to wash your hair, do so with your regular shampoo. Then rinse hair and body thoroughly to remove any shampoo residue.
- Avoid getting Hibiclens in your eyes, nose, ears, mouth or genital areas.
- Apply Hibiclens soap to a wet washcloth. Focus on the area of your body that you will have surgery, cleansing for 5 minutes.
- Do not scrub your skin or use a brush.
- Do not shave any hair from your body.
- Dry your body with a clean towel.
- Do not apply any lotions, powders, perfumes, makeup or hair products after washing.
- Wear clean clothing and sleep in clean bedding.
- If you have a splint or bandage, do not remove this or get it wet prior to surgery.

DIRECTIONS

FROM THE WEST:

Take Hwy 212 East. Exit on Hwy 41. At Hwy 41 turn left (north). Turn right on Hundertmark Road. Two Twelve Medical Center is located on your right at 111 Hundertmark Road, just before Hwy 212.

FROM THE EAST:

Take I-494 West to Hwy 212 West. Exit on Hwy 41 and turn right (north). Turn right on Hundertmark Road. Two Twelve Medical Center is located on your right at 111 Hundertmark Road.

FROM THE NORTH

Take I-494 South to Hwy 212 West. Exit on Hwy 41 and turn right (north). Turn right on to Hundertmark Road. Two Twelve Medical Center is located on your right at 111 Hundertmark Road.

FROM THE SOUTH:

Take Hwy 169 North to Hwy 41 North. Continue on Hwy 41 North and turn right on Hundertmark Road. Two Twelve Medical Center is located on your right at 111 Hundertmark Road.
